Old Business:

Previous meeting minutes reviewed and approved

- No adverse comments regarding plan for subdivision at corner of Eckhardt and Schoellkopf
- Shared with Committee feedback received from Walter Rooth dated 9/8/2017 that he wasn't aware of a legal ramifications that would require his involvement. Committee to move forward with plan to request removal of light consistent with email received 8/2/2017 from Gina Wilkolaski, P.E. | Traffic Safety Engineer Erie County.
- Camp Rd. Tim Hortons concern regarding vehicles taking left where posted No Left. The committee reviewed the suggestion for medication to the parking lot entry/exits. It was concluded that such modifications would not be feasible based upon multiple businesses occupying the property. The recommendation is for increased enforcement to address failure to obey No Left Turn signage.
- Committee recommends increased enforcement and request sent to County to widen and repave Heltz Rd. to help address increased traffic and speeding.
- Committee looking into possible signage to address concern relating to bicyclists crossing RR on Lakeview Rd if/when vehicles are crossing also.

New Business:

Mike B. noted that the County is supposed to conduct feasibility study for round-about at Armor/Bayview/Clark/Abbott intersection
