Old Business:

Previous meeting minutes reviewed and approved

1. No adverse comments regarding West Herr parking expansion (Camp Road)
2. No adverse comments regarding proposed cellular tower (Pleasant Avenue)
3. TSAB recommends traffic impact study for Glen Wetzel Sr. housing project on S. Western. TSAB would like to review project again once traffic impact study is completed
4. Resolution to be submitted for posting of bicycle signage at RR consistent with MUTCD Section 9B.06 Bicycles May Use Full Lane Sign (R4-11)
5. Recommend submittal of resolution to Board for County to lower speed on Heltz Rd. to 30 mph. In addition, request of County support in identifying suitable measures to protect pedestrians on Heltz Rd. based on the minimal shoulder in existence nearest Discovery School.

New Business:

1. Mike B. to adjust light at McKinley and Lake to allow more time for vehicles to turn.
2. Request of police to increase enforcement at College and Columbia for speeding vehicles, ignoring of stop signs and illegal parking.
3. Request to State to add traffic arrows on Rt. 5 heading south/west at Rogers, Amsdell, Pleasant and Lakeview during evening rush hour (4 to 6 pm) to address high volume and backups at intersections for vehicles making left turns.
