OLD BUSINESS

Approval of November 16, 2017 minutes

This item was tabled until all members receive a copy of the minutes to review.

Proposed Tim Horton's (6550 Southwestern Boulevard)

Chris Wood, engineer for the project, made a short presentation outlining the proposed project. Numerous residents spoke about their concerns about the adverse potential traffic impacts of this project through their neighborhood, and they were advised to voice those concerns to the Planning Board. Coordinator Giglio read two (2) letters from nearby residents (Mr. & Mrs. Gerald Miller and Mr. David Leyh) to the New York State Department of Transportation and the corresponding responses sent to the residents.

TSAB members concurred that the recommendation to the Planning Board regarding the internal traffic flow for this proposed project is as follows:

- A curb or sidewalk should be installed between the two (2) rows of proposed interior parking spaces so that patrons exiting the drive-thru cannot cut through the parking lot to exit the site.
- As an alternative to the above, directional signage and pavement arrows should be installed, and employees should be mandated to park in those two (2) rows of proposed interior parking spaces to dissuade patrons from exiting the drive-thru and cutting through the parking lot.
