Reynolds, versus Town of Hamburg, Thomas Best, Jr., Michael Quinn, and Steven Walters, Index Number I 2016-76, is currently pending in the New York State Supreme Court, Erie County, seeking reinstatement to full time employment and monetary damages against the Defendants,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Town of Hamburg approve the settlement of the aforementioned action as follows: the Town of Hamburg shall pay Brigit J. Reynolds the sum of \$20,000.00, reinstate Brigit J.
