Meeting called to order at 7:00 P.M. by TSAB Coordinator Jerry Giglio

**NEW BUSINESS**

**Resident of 4736 Maplewood Ct. would like a “Slow Down Be a Good Neighbor” sign installed on his street.**

Ms. Gillette made a motion to forward a resolution to the Town Board recommending approval of the installation of the requested signage.

On the question:

Members discussed where the sign would be located.

All members voted in favor of the motion.

**Resident of 4815 Edgewood Dr. requests that a “Children at Play” sign be installed.**

Members discussed the unique circumstances of the request (autistic children) and the fact that this type of sign is not usually erected on a residential street where it is assumed that there are children.

All members voted in favor of forwarding a resolution to the Town Board recommending approval of the installation of two (2) “Children at Play” signs.

**Holy Trinity Church, Woodlawn, requests permission to install “No Parking... by Police Order ... will be Towed” signage on property.**

Mr. Giglio read a letter from Maria Heftka, recording secretary at Holy Trinity National Catholic Church, requesting permission to post two (2) police-enforced signs in the church parking areas to stop vehicles and tractor trailers from pulling in and parking there.

Mr. Dunne made a motion, seconded by Ms. Gillette, to request that the Town Legal Department add Holy Trinity National Catholic Church to Local Law # 10. All members voted in favor of the motion.

**Unidentified caller complaint regarding sight distance at intersection of Division St. @ Norway during school hours.**

Members agreed that Mr. Bennett will investigate whether there is a missing “No Parking Here to Corner” sign at this corner, and if that is the case, he will reinstall the sign. If there never was a sign at that corner, Mr. Bennett will contact Mr. Giglio, and a resolution will be forwarded to the Town Board recommending that a new sign be installed.

**Review of TSAB minutes from August 2017 through December 2017**

Mr. Giglio will contact Ms. Gina Wilkolski, P.C., Erie County Traffic Safety Engineer, regarding the obsolete signal in front of Sacred Heart Church on Abbott Road in order to obtain the proper documentation for removal of the signal.

Members agreed that signage regarding bicyclists at railroad crossings will not be considered at this time.

Concerns from the property owner at 5436 Abel Road regarding vehicles driving on her lawn as they go around the curve near her property - Property owner wanted a guard rail on the outside of the curve. Members agreed that a guard rail will not be installed. Mr. Bennett will investigate the concern and whether additional signage is needed.

Members agreed that Mr. Bennett will investigate the new streets in the Deer Springs subdivision and where signage will be needed.

Members agreed that Draft minutes will be posted on the Town’s website when they are completed, and they will be amended as necessary.

Coordinator Giglio adjourned the meeting at 7:39 P.M.
