Meeting called to order at 7:00 P.M. by TSAB Coordinator Jerry Giglio

NEW BUSINESS

Hoak's Restaurant (4100 Lakeshore Road) proposes to construct a 440 sq.ft. addition to the restaurant (enclose the outdoor bar area)

Mr. Bapst made a motion, seconded by Mr. Tarnish, to recommend that a sign be erected on the vacant parcel across from Hoak's that is used for parking indicating that patrons should use the pedestrian cross walk at Big Tree Road to access the restaurant. All members voted in favor of the motion.

Resident @ 2053 Kennison Pkwy. @ Clifton Pkwy. Requests "Children at Play" signs installed.

Mr. Giglio made a motion, seconded by Mr. Bennett, to recommend to the Town Board that stops signs be erected on Kennison Parkway where it intersects Clifton Parkway. All members voted in favor of the motion.

Resident @ 219 South Shore Dr. requests installation of "Deaf Child" signs at each end of South Shore Dr. to alert motorists.

Mr. Giglio made a motion, seconded by Mr. Bennett, to recommend to the Town Board that "Deaf Child" signs be erected at each end of South Shore Drive. All members voted in favor of the motion.

Home @ 5023 Chapman Pkwy. Requests "Blind Child" sign installation.

Mr. Giglio made a motion, seconded by Mr. Tarnish, to recommend to the Town Board that "Blind Child" signs be erected on Chapman Parkway in the vicinity of 5023 Chapman Parkway

to be located in accordance with the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD). All members voted in favor of the motion.

Complaint from North Shore resident stating vehicles entering bike path at Hoover Rd. turn around by Rust Belt restaurant.

Mr. Dunne made a motion, seconded by Mr. Bapst, to recommend that a “No Motor Vehicles” sign be erected at the southernmost terminus of the bike path at Hoover Road. All members voted in favor of the motion.

Request for “No Parking” signs at Amsdell Road at Route 20

This request was discussed and tabled.

OLD BUSINESS

Mr. Bennett stated that the TSAB is awaiting documentation from Ellicott Development regarding the possible continued use of the signal in front of Sacred Heart Church on Lake Avenue.

TSAB determined that no action is required regarding the placement of signage in the vicinity of 5436 Abel Road.
