Meeting called to order at 7:00 P.M. by TSAB Coordinator Jerry Giglio

NEW BUSINESS

Proposed residential project on the site of the former Immaculata school (east side of South Park Avenue)

TSAB recommends to the Planning Board that the second access to Bayview Road be an open access – ingress/egress road.

Proposed Holiday Grove project on Taylor Road (at the site of the former Willowbend Tennis Club)

TSAB makes no recommendation at this time. If the project is approved and a problem arises, the TSAB will review this again.

Resident requests “Slow Down, Be a Good Neighbor” sign posted at the entrance of the Willow Woods Subdivision (Willowridge Drive)

TSAB members approved the requested sign.

Resident requests a “Slow Down, Be a Good Neighbor” sign posted on Logans Lane

TSAB members approved the requested sign.

Resident at 4204 Sheva Lane requests “No Parking” sign in front of her home

Coordinator Giglio stated that currently there are some “No Parking” signs on Sheva Lane, and some are missing. Mr. Bennett will reinstall the signs that are missing. The resident will alert the TSAB if the problem still exists after the signs are reinstalled.

Parking problems on Thurston Avenue near Abbott Road

Coordinator Giglio stated that residents of Thurston Avenue are concerned that patrons and employees of the Poked Yolk restaurant on Abbott Road are parking on both sides of Thurston Avenue. He stated that the local fire department has also expressed concerns about the parked cars potentially impeding emergency vehicles’ access on that street.

TSAB will request immediate permission to erect a “No Parking” sign on the south side of the street approximately 350 feet from the Abbott Road intersection and a “No Parking” sign on the north side of the street approximately 250 feet from the Abbott Road intersection.

TSAB members discussed the existing “No Right Turn on Red” sign at the eastern exit of the Tops Plaza on McKinley Parkway and whether it is necessary. Coordinator Giglio will research this.

TSAB members discussed the gas station across from the Armor Inn and the traffic problems at that intersection, especially the exit onto Clark Street. Mr. Bennett will research this.

TSAB members discussed a problem on West Parkway and agreed to install a “Be a Good Neighbor” sign on that street to slow vehicles down.

Coordinator Giglio adjourned the meeting at 7:45 P.M.
