Meeting called to order at 7:00 P.M. by TSAB Coordinator Jerry Giglio.

NEW BUSINESS

Proposed rezoning on the northwest corner of Big Tree Road and Southwestern Boulevard for a proposed Speedway gas station/convenience store

Board members agreed to table this item until the NYSDOT review of the traffic study is complete.

Residents of Brompton Drive request shoulder lines (fog lines) and bike paths

Board members agreed that two (2) 12-foot lanes should be designated, along with two (2) five-foot bike lanes, which will leave two (2) 2 ½ feet shoulders. This item will be referred back to the Town Board and Highway Superintendent for approval.

Residents request a Stop Sign at the Lakeview Terrace playground

Board members agreed that the requested signage is not warranted in front of the playground, and the request was denied.

Resident at 3800 Columbia Street requests a Stop Sign at the corner of College Street and Columbia Street

The property owner at 3800 Columbia Street was sent petitions for neighboring residents to sign and return to Mr. Giglio. Awaiting the response.

Request for a Stop Sign on the corner of Ridgefield Terrace and Castleridge

Board members agreed that the requested signage is not warranted, and the request was denied.

OLD BUSINESS:

Status of Our Lady of the Sacred Heart traffic signal

It was determined that the traffic signal has been removed.

Report from Mr. Bennett regarding the need for additional Area Speed Limit signs on Lakeview Terrace

Mr. Bennett stated that all the streets in the neighborhood have Area Speed Limit signs.

Resident on Harvard Street would like No Parking restriction extended on the south side of Harvard Street from College Street to present restriction in front of house # 3895. Tabled on September 12, 2019.

Board members agreed to table this request until such time as petitions are returned.

- Ms. Laura Podkulski, 4332 McKinley Parkway, stated that the “No Right Turn on Red” sign at the exit of the Tops McKinley Parkway onto McKinley Parkway was taken down. Mr. Giglio advised Ms. Podkulski that the TSAB took the sign down because of a member concern. Ms. Podkulski stated that the sign was required when the Benderson buildings adjacent to the Tops were approved, and it was put up for her family’s safety getting out of their driveway.

Board members agreed to have the sign reinstalled as close to McKinley Parkway as possible.
