Meeting called to order at 7:00 P.M. by TSAB Coordinator Jerry Giglio

NEW BUSINESS

Discussion of revised ingress/egress for the proposed residential project on the site of the former Immaculata School

Chairman Giglio read correspondence from both the Erie County Department of Public Works and the New York State Department of Transportation regarding the above project, both of which indicated that based on the updated Traffic Impact Study, the additional traffic generated by the proposed development will not have a significant impact on the level of service of either South Park Avenue or Sowles Road.

Mr. Dunne commented that without the access to Bayview Road, the fire company will have to enter the development from South Park Avenue.

Proposed storage building project on the northeast corner of Big Tree Road and Lakeshore Road

Ms. Gillette expressed a concern that there needs to be enough room for trucks to turn around on the property. She further stated that she would like to see the driveway as far away from the lighted intersection as possible.

Mr. Dunne suggested that signage be installed to make sure that any large trucks exiting the site turn right only and not left towards the low bridge on Big Tree Road.

It was determined that there would be no deliveries to the site from tractor trailers.

Members agreed that the TSAB would have no comments for the Planning Board regarding this project.

Proposed cellular tower to be located at 4999 McKinley Parkway (owned by the Wesleyan Church)

It was determined that the TSAB will review this project at its April meeting.

Confirmation of all members' contact information

Members present confirmed that the Planning Department has the correct contact information for them.

Members' comments

Members discussed the viaduct on Big Tree Road and whether the County should be contacted about adding flashing lights approaching the viaduct.
