NEW BUSINESS

TSAB review of proposed Pleasant View Estates Subdivision (north side of Pleasant Avenue, just west of Meadow Run)

TSAB will require that the following signage be installed:

- Stop sign at the intersection of Pleasant Avenue and the new street
- “No Outlet” sign on the new street
- “Slow Down, Be a Good Neighbor” on the new street
- Street name signs
- Stop sign where the two proposed roads intersect at the crosswalk

Residents of Hobblebush Lane request a Stop Sign at the corner of Hobblebush Lane and Agassiz Drive

TSAB recommends that a Stop Sign be installed on Hobblebush Lane where it meets Agassiz Drive.
