Meeting called to order at 7:00 P.M. by TSAB Coordinator Jerry Giglio.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Dr. Philip Stokes from Penn Dixie addressed the Board regarding issues involving traffic safety at the entrance to the Penn Dixie site. He requested speed bumps and a gated entrance. The TSAB discussed the possibility of a drive being established off of Jeffrey Boulevard to the Penn Dixie site. Mr. Dunne stated that this subject was discussed by a previous TSAB in the early 2000s. The TSAB will also look into the possibility of grant money through Mark Melewski. J. Giglio will try to arrange a meeting with the Hamburg Supervisor, the Highway Superintendent and Dr. Stokes regarding the possibility of a potential drive to the Penn Dixie site from Jeffrey Boulevard.
2. **Resident of Deer Springs would like a Stop/Yield sign installed at Tim Hortons on Route 20 for vehicles exiting the parking lot onto White Oak Way (concerns are near misses and pedestrians).** Tabled.
3. **Install a 35 MPH speed limit sign on Heltz Road between Route 20 and Lakeview Road.** Mr. Bennett will install appropriate speed limit sign on Heltz Road as requested.
4. **Resident @ 4944 Winterway Lane would like a Stop sign installed in front of home to reduce near miss accidents at the intersection of Winterway and Autumnway.**

Tabled. Mike Bennett will increase the size of the existing Stop sign on Autumnway to 36" X 36" and will trim the trees around the sign.

- 5. Resident on Harvard Street would like No Parking Restriction extended on the south side of Harvard Street from College Street to present restriction in front of house # 3895. Approx. 2/10 of a mile. Complaint is parking on both sides of street obstructing traffic / emergency vehicles.** Tabled. The TSAB will mail petitions to the homeowner at 3973 Harvard Street for resident input.
- 6. Residents in Hoover Beach community request weight Limit signing on Hoover Road due to increase in Semi-Truck traffic.** TSAB members agreed with residents' concerns regarding semi-truck traffic on Hoover Road. The TSAB will recommend to the Town Board that "No Truck Traffic" signs be installed with a supplemental panel "Delivery Vehicles Only" at Hoover Road's intersection with Bayview Road and at Hoover Road's intersection with Route 5.
7. The TSAB reviewed a petition it received from residents of Smith Road requesting speed limit reduction between Pleasant Avenue and Lakeview Road. The TSAB will recommend to the Town Board that the speed limit be reduced from 35 MPH to the Town speed limit of 30 MPH between Pleasant Avenue and Lakeview Road.
8. Mr. Bennett will check the Lakeview Heights area for proper signage regarding the speed limit in that area.

Members' comments

Mr. Walterich informed the TSAB of residents' complaints regarding No Right Turn sign exiting the Tops Market on McKinley Parkway. The TSAB agreed to the removal of said sign due to changes in traffic patterns.

Coordinator Giglio adjourned the meeting at 8:00 P.M.
